LIFTING OF COVID RESTRICTIONS

As a Christian community we need to have central in our thoughts the needs of
the vulnerable and these should, if necessary, override our own individual
desires and wishes. It is with this in mind that we continue to make the
following provisions.

Social distancing where possible is still encouraged.

Face masks are now a matter of personal choice. Clergy still use them at the
Eucharistic Prayer and distribution.

We shall aim for the greatest amount of ventilation.

Communion can now be received as either just the bread (in one kind) or bread
dipped in the wine (intincted).

As before these measures are subject to change and will be reviewed regularly
